With the generous support of the McKnight Foundation, MacPhail Center for Music awards fellowships which recognize and support outstanding Minnesota performing musicians. The McKnight Artist Fellowships provide financial support, professional development opportunities and recognition to musicians as they explore their craft and develop their musicianship skills and performance style while enriching Minnesota's cultural community.

The Fellowships for Performing Musicians program, administered by MacPhail Center for Music, is one component of the McKnight Foundation Artist Fellowships program, which contributes more than \$1.5 million per year to assist individual artists in 11 disciplines. Awards

Each year, \$24,000 fellowships are awarded to outstanding solo musicians or small ensembles.
